

**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove lines 18-29 and insert:

63.0422 Prohibited conditions on adoptions; firearms and ammunition; sexual orientation.—An adoption agency or entity, whether public or private, may not:

(1) Make a determination that a person is unsuitable to adopt based on:

(a) The lawful possession, storage, or use of a firearm or ammunition by any member of the adoptive home.

(b) The person's sexual orientation.

(2) Require an adoptive parent or prospective adoptive parent to disclose information relating to:

(a) A person's lawful possession, storage, or use of a firearm or ammunition as a condition to adopt.

(b) A person's sexual orientation.

(3) Restrict the lawful possession, storage, or use of a firearm or ammunition as a condition for a person to adopt. Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 63.042, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

63.042 Who may be adopted; who may adopt.—

Remove lines 2-6 and insert:

An act relating to adoption; creating s. 63.0422, F.S.; prohibiting an adoption agency or entity from making suitability determinations based on, requiring disclosure relating to, or restricting the lawful possession, storage, or use of a firearm or ammunition or based on or requiring disclosure relating to sexual orientation; amending s. 63.042, F.S.; repealing a prohibition on the eligibility of homosexuals to adopt; amending s.
